Campsite Restrictions for Summer/Autumn 2020

For the safety of our guests and staff this season, we are imposing the following restrictions.

- We only accept campsite bookings for Motorhomes/Campervans and Caravans which are entirely self-sufficient in respect of washing, toilet and shower facilities. All on-site facilities are closed for the duration.
- Awnings will only be accepted by prior agreement and may be required to be pitched on hard standing. Whilst we will endeavour to mow the grass when the site is empty, you may be asked to vacate the site whilst this is done.
- Fresh water is available from the standpipe. You will need to provide your own hosepipe.
- The sluice room will be open for emptying of cartridges. Guests must use the cleaning spray provided after each use and are strongly advised to wear gloves which must be disposed of immediately in the bin provided.
- No bookings will be accepted for tents or smaller campervans without full on-board facilities.
- There is no access to the facilities normally available in the cabin (washing machine, fridges, microwave etc.)
- Bookings must be paid for in advance by BACS transfer or by card over the telephone.
- Guest movement on site is restricted to the site only and we ask that social distancing rules are adhered to at all times. Regretfully, no visitors are permitted.
- The North gate (top corner of campsite) is open to enable access on foot to the moor. Guests may only move between the campsite and the main gate in a vehicle. Parents please note that the play area and sandpit are not in use.
- Rubbish must be securely bagged and tied and left in the designated area by the toilet block. Please do not leave anything that will not fit into a black bin bag.
- We regret we will not be offering use of fire pits this year and request that no BBQ devices which generate ash are used on site.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead or tether at all times. There is no separate dog walking area on the farm.
- It is with sadness that we will not be offering any of our usual catering options this year. This includes our customary complimentary cream tea on arrival.
